

Crisp County-Cordele Airport Runway Safety Project.

Sealed Proposals will be received by the owner, Crisp County Board of Commissioners at the Crisp County Government Center, **210 South 7th Street, Room 303, Cordele, Georgia 31015**, until **2:00 p.m. on the 4th day of February, 2019**, for the **construction of the Runway Safety Area** for Crisp County-Cordele Airport in Crisp County, Georgia. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 p.m. at Crisp County Government Center at 210 South 7th Street, Cordele, Georgia. Proposals received after the designated time will not be considered. This project is funded under Airport Improvement Program (AIP) by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA.) This project is required to comply with the requirements of the Civil Rights office for Disadvantage Business Enterprise Program. The goal for these programs is set at 7.33%.

The Contractor's Proposal will include the furnishing of all labor, materials, equipment, and all things necessary pursuant to Drawings, Specifications and Conditions, etc., for Runway Safety Area Improvements – Phase I for Crisp County-Cordele Airport, RAC 15005.20 (the "Project").

The Project generally consists of improvements (demolition, grading, paving, remarking and lighting adjustments) to Runway '10' and '28' Safety Area as shown on the plans.
