

**MINUTES OF THE CRISP COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
CALLED MEETING HELD ON JUNE 27, 2017**

OPENING CEREMONIES

Chairman Sam Farrow, Jr. called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m. in Room 305 of the Crisp County Government Center. Commissioners present were Wallace Mathis, Larry Felton and J. R. Dowdy, III. Commissioner Dowdy gave the invocation and Administrator Patton led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

ADOPT FY 18 FINAL BUDGET

Mrs. Leverett reported that this is the last step in the process of adopting the FY 18 budget. She advised that we had the public hearing on June 13th, it has been advertised according with the state code and everything is balanced. She read the resolution with the estimated revenues and expenditures are as follows: General Fund - \$14,800,054, Law Library - \$40,000, Jail Maintenance Fund - \$215,150, D.A.T.E. Fund - \$43,000, E911 Fund - \$956,594, TSPLOST Special Revenue Fund - \$728,000, CDBG - \$50,952, Special Service District - \$1,657,800, Hotel/Motel Fund - \$40,000, Asset Forfeiture Fund - \$72,500, 2000 SPLOST - \$100,000, 2005 SPLOST - \$210,000, 2011 SPLOST - \$1,805,814, TSPLOST Capital Projects Fund - \$220,000, Water Fund - \$647,400, Landfill Fund - \$1,646,187, CDBG RLF - \$17,100, Asset Forfeiture Fund - \$100,500 with total Crisp County FY 2018 Budget at \$23,351,051. **Motion was made by Mr. Dowdy to adopt the Crisp County FY 2018 Budget at \$23,351,051, seconded by Mr. Felton, motion carried unanimously.**
