

**MINUTES OF THE CRISP COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
BUDGET PUBLIC HEARING HELD ON MAY 29, 2018**

Chairman Sam Farrow opened the public hearing at 10:00 a.m. with Commissioners Wallace Mathis, Larry Felton and J. R. Dowdy, III in attendance. Sherrie Leverett reported that the public hearing is for the FY 2019 county-wide budget. She advised that the public hearing was advertised in compliance with the requirements for the budget public hearing. She stated that there is also a public notice that will be ran letting the public know that we will be adopting the budget in our regular meeting on June 12, 2018. She advised that all the funds are now balanced: General Fund at \$16,063,480 which includes \$677,556 from surplus; Special Service District Fund at \$1,723,350; Special Revenue Funds at \$2,335,854; Special Local Option Sales Tax Funds at \$5,881,323; TSPLOST – Capital Projects Fund at \$291,233; Water Distribution Fund at \$651,450; and the Landfill Fund at \$1,724,700 bringing the county-wide total to \$26,295,240. Chairman Farrow asked if anyone had any questions regarding the budget, and there were none. Chairman Farrow closed the public hearing at 10:16 a.m.
