

**MINUTES OF THE CRISP COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
CALLED MEETING HELD ON DECEMBER 29, 2021**

Chairman Sam N. Farrow, Jr. called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. in Room 305 of the Crisp County Government Center, with Commissioners A. James Nance, Larry Felton, J. R. Dowdy, III, and Mark Crenshaw in attendance. Others present were County Administrator Clark Harrell, and County Attorney Rick Lawson. Reverend Leon Hughes gave the Invocation and County Administrator, Clark Harrell, led those in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States of America.

ADOPT PROCLAMATION HONORING THE RETIREMENT OF GAIL SIMS


Administrator Harrell advised he had a Proclamation honoring the forthcoming retirement of Gail Sims, Associate Magistrate Judge. Commissioner Nance read the Proclamation stating that Gail Sims, hired in 1985, has been a loyal and dedicated employee for 36 years serving the citizens of Crisp County. **Motion was made by Commissioner Nance to adopt the Proclamation Honoring the Retirement of Gail Sims, seconded by Commissioner Dowdy, motion carried unanimously.** Mrs. Sims was presented with the Proclamation and she thanked the commissioners.

ADOPT REDISTRICTING MAP

County Administrator, Clark Harrell, presented a third draft-redistricting map for the Commission consideration. He advised the redistricting is a requirement by law after each census. The purpose of the redistricting is to true-up population in each Commission district. Mr. Harrell also reported that he has worked with the County Attorney, Rick Lawson, and individually with each County Commissioner on the redistricting proposals. No further discussion and County Administrator Harrell advised the Commission he will notify the Legislative Office of Reapportionment and the Legislative Office for the State Legislature's consideration. **Motion was made by Commissioner Nance to adopt third draft-redistricting map, seconded by Commissioner Felton, motion carried unanimously.**
