

**MINUTES OF THE CRISP COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
CALLED MEETING HELD ON JUNE 25, 2026**

Chairman, James Dowdy, III, called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. in Room 305 of the Crisp County Government Center, with Commissioners A. James Nance, Larry Felton, Sam Farrow, and Mark Crenshaw in attendance. Others present were County Administrator Mickey Dunnivant, Finance Director Sherrie Leverett and County Clerk Monica Irwin.

County Administrator, Mickey Dunnivant, stated, the first order of business is Resolution 2026-018 to adopt the Fiscal Year Budget of 2027. Mr. Dunnivant read the Resolution. **Motion was made by Commissioner Nance to adopt the Resolution for the 2027 Fiscal Year, motion seconded by Commissioner Felton, motion carried unanimously.**

Mr. Dunnivant stated, the next item of business is the Floating Local Option Sales Tax (FLOST) IGA. This was discussed in last months called meeting. The City of Cordele Mayor, Wesley Rainey, and Commissioners have signed the Intergovernmental Agreement between Crisp County and the City of Cordele for imposition of the Floating Local Option Sales Tax. Mr. Dunnivant stated, a motion is needed to ratify the signatures so we can move to the next stage of approving the Resolution to advertise. **Motion was made by Commissioner Nance to Ratify the Intergovernmental Agreement between Crisp County and the City of Cordele for imposition of the FLOST, seconded by Commissioner Felton, motion carried unanimously.**

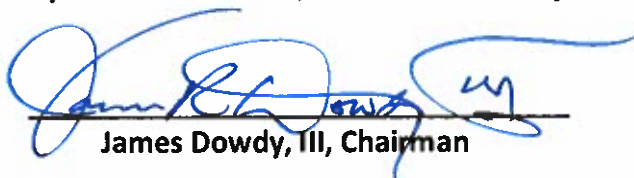
County Administrator, Mickey Dunnivant, stated, the last order of business is Resolution 2026-019. The Resolution is to call for the election of a one percent (1%) FLOST Referendum. Mr. Dunnivant read the Resolution. **Motion was made by Commissioner Felton to adopt the Resolution to call for a one percent (1%) FLOST Referendum to determine whether the voters desire a special one percent sales and use tax be imposed for five years within the special district of Crisp County with the proceeds to used exclusively to reduce property taxes imposed by Crisp County and the City of Cordele, seconded by Commissioner Nance, motion carried unanimously.**

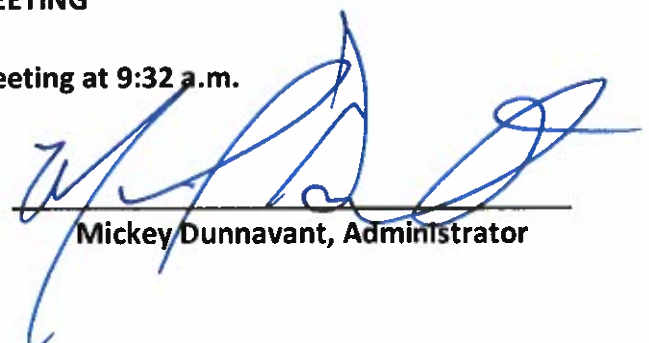
