- 1) How are service hours calculated?
- a. Does the timer start when the vehicle is dispatched, or
- b. Does the timer start when the passenger enters the vehicle?

Service Hours start when the vehicle is dispatched or leaves the yard and stop when the vehicle returns. Revenue Service Hours start when the passenger enters the vehicle and stop when the last passenger exits the vehicle.

- 2) Section C. Fleet Maintenance Questions
- a. The RFP says that all maintenance will be performed following the Crisp County maintenance policy. Can you supply a copy of the Maintenance Policy?

A sample policy from the County's current Contractor is attached as an addendum.

- b. The RFP says that the Contractor shall submit invoices for any work.
- i. Is my understanding correct in that all maintenance is managed and coordinated by the Contractor, and then also paid for at the time of service by the Contractor, and then reimbursed monthly at the time of invoicing?

All maintenance is managed and coordinated by the contractor. The contractor also pays for the service or repairs at the time of service. The contractor is not reimbursed for maintenance service or repairs. The cost of repairs and maintenance is included in the agreed upon unit rate.

c. Can you supply a copy of a recent monthly invoice for reference?

- Does the General Liability need to be independently \$3MM? No.

No. All listed roles within the RFP must be identified by name and accompanied with a description of experience. All proposed personnel must be on site.

c. Exhibit C: QRyde features/additions

GDOT provides QRyde scheduling/dispatch software at no cost. Other software is permissible at the cost of the Contractor. Any add-ons to QRyde are also permissible at the cost of the contractor. However, an onsite dispatcher/scheduler is still required.
